Val's Daughter makes these for our Halloween party, here is recipe for anyone interested!

TREAT SHEET



SEVERED FINGER COOKIES

MAKES 50 PREP 40 MIN (PLUS CHILLING) BAKE 25 MIN

- 1 cup unsalted butter, at room temperature
- 1 cup confectioners' sugar
- 1 egg
- 1 tsp. pure vanilla extract
- 2¾ cups flour
- 1 tsp. baking powder
- 1 tsp. salt
- ½ cup sliced almonds
- Raspberry jam

1. In a large bowl, beat the butter until creamy. Mix in the sugar, egg and vanilla, then mix in the flour, baking powder and salt. Cover the dough with plastic wrap and refrigerate for 30 minutes.
2. Preheat the oven to 325°. Using your hands and working quickly, roll a heaping tablespoon of dough into a finger shape. Place the fingers about 3 inches apart on an ungreased cookie sheet. Stick a sliced almond on 1 end of each for the fingernails. Use a table knife to make three crosswise knuckle marks in the middle of each cookie. Bake until lightly golden, 20 to 25 minutes. Transfer to a rack to cool.
3. Meanwhile, in a small saucepan, cook the jam over low heat until it reaches a saucy consistency. Once liquefied, remove from the heat and pour into a small bowl; dip the "severed" end of each cookie into the sauce.

Tip: In Step 2, if the dough gets sticky and hard to work with, return it to the refrigerator to re-chill.
