Old Business

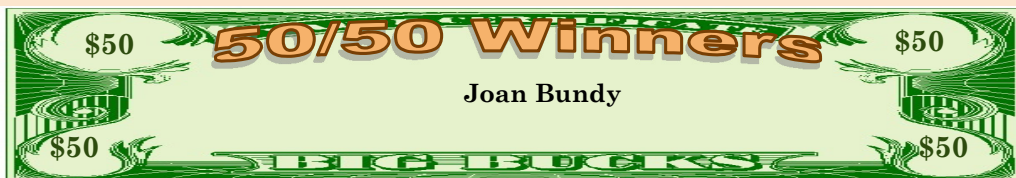

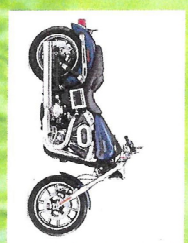
